The MAFFI Model A Hall of Fame

This September will mark the fourth year for inductions into the Model A Ford Hall of Fame. The induction of four new Hall of Fame members will take place at Model A Day VII festivities at the Museum September 16, 2017.

The MAFFI Model A Hall of Fame was launched in 2014 and is a component of the Model A Ford Museum. The first two inductees were, appropriately, Henry and Edsel Ford. In subsequent years, four new Hall of Fame members will be added each year. Candidates for the all of Fame are nominated and voted on by the Model A Ford Foundation Trustees. To be nominated, a Hall of Fame candidate must have a strong connection to some aspect of the Model A Ford – including functions as the design, development, manufacture, preservation, publication, recreational utilization. or affiliation with national, regional and local hobby organizations dedicated to the Model A Ford.

These four new annual inductees will come from two areas:

Two from the “production” areas – those involved with the restoration, development and production of the Model A -- including independent creators of supportive tools, adaptations and commercial modifications of the Model A.

In addition, two inductees will be from the “hobby” areas – those involved with the restoration, preservation,

Longtime MAFFI Supporter Passes Away in Michigan

When I first became aware of the Model A Ford Foundation I quickly realized that then-President Howard Minners had assembled a board of Trustees that looked and acted like champions. When Aldie Johnson, Sam Nixon and Bob Anderson walked into the room you saw that they were big men (all were well over six feet tall), carried themselves like royalty, were expert Model A'ers, and were as pleasant as anyone you will ever meet. All of them donated outstanding vehicles to the Model A Ford Museum, and laid the groundwork for the success of the Foundation.

Sadly, all of them are now gone. Aldie Johnson and Sam Nixon passed away several years ago, and now in recent days Bob Anderson has joined them. Bob was the Trustee who supervised the extensive work done by the Foundation at the Benson Ford Research Center. The uncategorized boxes of Model A Ford Mechanical Drawings containing tens of thousands of photographic negatives were examined one by one and recorded in an orderly process that resulted in an index of these drawings. The index is now available to everyone (see: <http://www.maffi.org/partsresearch/>) and are the basis for many accurate reproduction parts now available for Model A restorations.

As the museum took shape Bob Anderson was an avid supporter and donated two beautiful vehicles, a 1929 Phaeton and a 1930 Cabriolet. These vehicles remain in the museum today as a physical tribute to Bob and his lasting Model A legacy.

Executive Director's Report

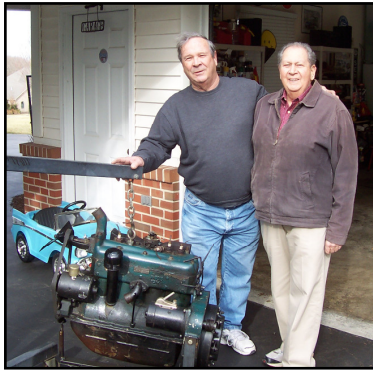

Giftting an IRA Charitable Rollover

This plan may be of special interest to our charity-minded members. It is particularly beneficial to those who take a Standard Deduction and do not itemize on Schedule A of the 1040 income tax return.

"The Protecting Americans from Tax Hikes Act of 2015", is now a permanent means to transfer an amount from your IRA without it being treated as an income.

Some Requirements and Restrictions:

Donor must be 70 ½ or older.

The gift must be outright, and no material benefits can be received in return.

The gift must be made DIRECTLY from the IRA to MAFFI.

The gift can be made only from a Traditional IRA (not from a 401K or other plan).

Benefits That May Make This Right For You:

If you are required to take a minimum distribution from your IRA.

If you do NOT itemize deductions, a RMS (normal distribution) will increase your taxable income.

If your State has income taxes, but does not allow itemized charitable deductions.

If you would like to make an additional gift, but are restricted by the 50% of adjusted gross income provision, the DIRECT IRA rollover is equivalent to a deduction.

You can arrange your special gift by instructing your IRA administrator, at ANYTIME during the year.

The Model A Ford Foundation invites you all to attend Model A Day at the Gilmore this year. The trustees will meet on Thursday, September 14th and have a work day at the museum on Friday, the 15th. If you arrive early on Friday, please stop at the Sheraton Four Points in Kalamazoo first to check out some of the interesting places to visit around town.

There will be a seminar at the hotel on Friday evening by former MAFFI president Stan Johnson on "How the Model A Ford Won WW II" at 7 pm which will introduce one of this year's special exhibits featuring a Russian manufactured GAZ engine and a right hand drive Phaeton built in England. These two vehicles introduce a multi-year A's Around the World exhibit. A second special exhibit this year is a milk delivery truck, the only 'stand-drive' truck produced during the Model A years.

We greatly appreciate Phil Ierardi of Missouri for the gift of the GAZ engine, John Marshall for the transmission and Lou Ironsides for gathering miscellaneous parts and reassembling everything including an engine stand to display the engine. We are also indebted to Tom Mack of South Carolina for the loan of his RHD Phaeton and to Dee Kaufman of Ohio, for the loan of Roger's Stand-drive Milk Truck. This will be a Model A Starting Display where kids from 8 to 80 can get behind the wheel of a Model A; and if successfully accomplishing all the steps required to start a Model A, will be rewarded by hearing a recording of a smoothly running Model A engine. Joe Hornacek and Ken Ehrenhofer have taken the lead on this exhibit and with the help of many others have brought this exhibit to fruition. It never fails to amaze me how people step up to help out when needed. Thanks to all who had a part in this project, whether you tightened a bolt or worked out the master plan.

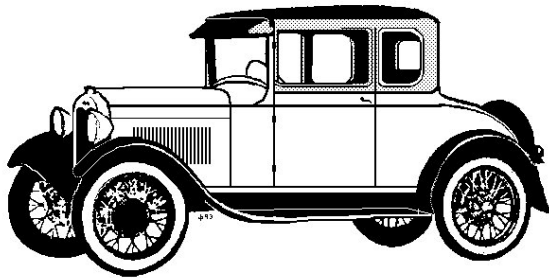
