


Since we were unable to have an official Model A Day this year, it was decided that we would create a pin as a fund raiser to help us raise money that would have normally come from our event.

MAFCA & MARC Presidents Visit Model A Ford Museum

While the COVID-19 pandemic caused the official closing of the 2020 Model A Day festivities at the Model A Ford Museum, a small group of MAFFI Trustees and volunteers were on-site that weekend to make sure at least some of the traditional Model A Day activities could still take place. On September 18-19, 2020 (the originally-scheduled 2020 Model A Day dates), these volunteers participated in a MAFFI "work day" and assisted in setting up Museum displays, placing MAFFI memorial bricks and performing Museum maintenance activities.

The annual Model A Ford Hall of Fame induction ceremony was also conducted -- on a virtual/ videotaped basis and attended by a limited "socially-distanced" audience of family members of the four Hall of Fame inductees. The somewhat quiet time at the Museum provided the opportunity for conducting and videotaping several tours of the various Museum displays – including the recently assembled multi-vehicle exhibit of Model A and Model AA First Responder vehicles.

The Foundation was honored to have several special guests attend the Model A Ford Hall of Fame induction ceremony. In addition to Les Andrews (2020 HOF inductee) and about 20 family members of HOF inductees, Bill Truesdell (current MAFCA President), Rusty Gould (former MAFCA President) and Joe Fox (current MARC President) were on hand for the ceremony. Ken Ehrenhofer served as the on-site photographer and Mark Maron provided the live-feed video and videotaping services to record the day's activities.

Prior to the Hall of Fame ceremony, John Begg, MAFFI President, led our distinguished visitor group on a tour of the current Museum displays. This tour, the Hall of Fame induction ceremony, and several additional Museum tours were videotaped and will be available for viewing on the MAFFI website – *www.maffi.org*.

The Bus Project Body is nearing Completion....An Update!

The restoration of a Model AA Bus is a project of major proportions! Starting a project of this size is in many ways, I must admit, almost overwhelming. Having a lot of experience in

restoring cars I knew there were going to be many challenges but I also knew, somehow, we could overcome these challenges. To tell you the truth, I just had confidence we could find these solutions to these many challenges.





One of these challenges that I am referring to is the body work and panel repair. The body panels and the cowl section, which upon disassembly, showed signs of significant rust out and damage from many years of water damage from many repaired areas from running into who know what!

We called upon a Restoration Shop of high caliber to help us duplicate the side panels and rust repair called Chicago Parts and Sound Inc., owned by Bob Lederer.



His metal master, Sam Waltermire, has done an outstanding job of duplicating all the side panels and is now working on repairing the cowl section. I might add this cowl section is one of the worst I have ever seen and to restore it is a real challenge.

So first we looked for a better one. Steve Burton gave us one but it was not the right year or style so I found one in Connecticut and after picking it up we decided it was worse than the one we already had... the challenges continue.






Ron Ehrenhofer found some pieces at Bert's Model A Center in Denver and has reconstructed the bottom of the cowl. Sam the Metal Man has made new sides and between the two of them we are restoring a piece of real junk and it is looking like a brand new cowl thanks to Sam and Ron. Overcoming these challenges is nothing more than to find the right people who know how to do miraculous work to bring these pieces back to new condition.
