MAFFI Model AA Bus Project Update

The Bus is "Rolling Along"

If you are going to catch this bus you better hurry.....

They are moving quickly as the Bus is rounding a pivotal turn. The front cowl is being readied for a color coat along with the sides and the rear panel. The color will be Duchess Blue and Tacoma Cream Wheels and window reveal. These first coats are mainly to spray a coating in areas where, after the body assembly, will not be available to get a protective coating.



A visit to the Greenfield Village Auto shop was made by Ron and Ken Ehrenhofer and two seats were borrowed from their bus for duplication. Ron and Ken have made window stop brackets for the Village bus and repaired a window bracket and will get it plated for them. Gordy has been so helpful that we are trying to help them as they work on the bus during the off season.


Ron and Ken disassembled the seats at Addison Auto Trim with Jim, the owner, who has offered to do all of the upholstery work. We had a discussion of how this would be accomplished. We will also need to restore the seats we borrowed as they are in pretty sad condition. We are currently waiting for a quote from

Chicago Tube and Iron to cover the cost of bending all the tubing pieces so we can weld up eight new double seats for our bus.

A work bay has been cleaned out at Ken's Barn and the chassis has been placed in the bay with plenty of room all the way around for the assembly work to begin.

The floor has been under construction at Moss Designs in Oshkosh, Wisconsin. Russ Moss is the son in law of Jerry Braasch who is chairing the MARC National meet in Oshkosh. Russ is a master woodworker and cabinet maker and has duplicate the floor. Russ cut down ash trees and kiln dried the lumber to make the new floor. He has made many other pieces for the walls and window regulators. He is currently working on some plywood pieces that will be used in the construction of our bus and the bus seats for the Village bus also.


Within the next couple of months, we are expecting to start raising the walls and the rear and front panels and the "Bus Body" will once again start to look like a "BUS"...the excitement is building!
