



estoring a bus is a really big job but we look at it as "thousands of small projects to complete". When I say small projects that does not mean that they do not require hundreds of hours to restore and complete. One of these projects was the windshield. The bottom was rotted away and needed to be replaced. Ron Ehrenhofer was the lead person and he relied on help from our master machinist and good Model A friend, Larry Rust. (Octavia Tool). The bottom rail of the windshield was cut from solid stock, a special cutter was made to cut a Tee shape into the steel so the tee rubber would fit and hold in position. Larry and Ron have spent months restoring the windshield frame. It now looks new and ready to go into the spray booth for prime and final paint. In the photos, you can see the slots cut into the steel for the glass and rubber trim and you can also see many, many holes drilled into the rail so it would not weigh so much and put a strain on the welded joints. After painting it will go for a new glass windshield....the project keeps moving forward! ~ Ken Ehrenhofer

ur theme this year is open cars. Bring your roadsters, roadster trucks, cabriolets, phaetons and 400As to show off.

There will be a special gate for Model A parking. It will be located on Hickory Road. Please enter there and someone will guide you onto the Gilmore grounds and to the Model A parking area.

Friday, we will be doing a First Start for a car that has not been started in decades. That will be at 2PM and is always a fun event.

Friday, you will have the opportunity to participate in the Model A Driving Experience. This is a classroom, as well as a hands on, driving school. The class will run from 1PM to 4PM. *The cost is* \$100 per person and you must preregister online for this class.

Saturday, there will be a Fashion Seminar, a technical seminar on the ABC's of the model A engine, Road-trip 101 and we will have a special guest talking about the Great Race. All of these seminars will be on Saturday from 9:30 to 2:15. The cost for each seminar is \$5 and will be collected at the door, on the day of the event. After noon on Friday and all day Saturday, we will have "Ride the A's" where you will get your chance to take a spin around the Gilmore campus in a Model A and our AA Stakebed truck — maybe even the Model A School Bus.

There will be a Special Event on Friday evening at the Kellogg Bird Sanctuary with a catered dinner and the ability to tour the Kellogg Manor House. Dinner and admission to the Bird Sanctuary and Manor House will be \$45 per person and you must preregister online.
