e have just completed our annual Model A Days at The Gilmore Car Museum in Hickory Corners, Michigan. This marks our second year in which the event has been expanded to a two-day affair. While it is hard to have an exact count, estimates of over 1500 visitors and 275 Model A-s were spotted all around the beautiful 90 acre campus. We had four outstanding seminars, as well as a two-day swap meet, a driver's school for Model A-s, opportunities to ride in several Model A's throughout the weekend, and a Friday night tour and dinner at The Kellogg Bird Sanctuary in Kalamazoo. Larry Shepard and a crew of volunteers brought a couple of long dormant Model A's back to life with his "First Start" program and we inducted 4 new members into The Hall of Fame. Being inducted into The Model A Ford Foundation Hall of Fame is the highest honor we can bestow upon individuals that have been instrumental in the production, marketing, and preservation of the Model A.

Our big news was the announcement of the expansion of our museum, doubling its current size, with a planned ribbon cutting date of September 2025. In addition to more interactive displays and vintage era vignettes, the plans call for a working garage that will serve as a learning center for our hobby. One of the exciting ways an individual can support the museum and have their Model A(s) recognized in the museum is through our newly established "My A" program. A plaque will be created and displayed in the new museum expansion showing the owner's name and location, as well as a color picture of the owner's Model A. Great News Model A Ford Foundation Museum Trustee and Treasurer, Mark Maron Update

Mark was diagnosed with Pulmonary Fibrosis in 2016 and began using oxygen in 2018 on a limited basis, and in 2019 was using oxygen full time. He reached end stage lung disease in 2023 and was on borrowed time. On December 12th, he received the gift of life and a lung transplant at Loyola University Medical Center.

There have been serious complications, but it seems like he is

headed in the right direction. On December 30th, Val, his wife, reported that Mark had been released from the hospital and was at home. They are traveling the difficult road of recovery. This will be a long, long process.

Your continued prayers during this time are most appreciated. Mark is not ready for phone calls; however, he can be reached via email (a7191mark@gmail.com), text (847-302-7900), or Facebook. Cards and letters can be mailed to 417 Oak Grove Circle, Wauconda, IL 60084. Mark is not able to have visitors for another 3 months, as his immune system is quite compromised.

We are hopeful that he will have a complete recovery and will be back with us in September for Model A Days 2024.
